Thanks for including Bob Thomas's clear, concise, and insightful comments. His view provided at least token balance in an otherwise unanimous approval of evangelical use of redaction criticism.

One is at a loss to understand why this redaction "baby," conceived and nurtured by liberals, has been mutilated and then adopted by evangelicals. Why did Matthew, Mark, and John

need to redact someone else's material when they were eyewitnesses of the events whose memories were supernaturally activated by the Holy Spirit to recall "all" that Jesus said?
